



Traffic Skills 101

Smart Cycling Course

Traffic Skills 101 is the foundation. It provides instruction and guidance in the basic principles of vehicular bicycling. Bicyclists have more fun, and are safer, when they ride with skill and confidence. The course combines classroom discussion (four hours) and parking lot activities with on-road practice of the principles of vehicular bicycling (five hours). The on-road experiences include quiet residential streets, minor arterials, multi-lane low- and moderate-speed arterials.

The instructors for this course are certified by the League of American Bicyclists.

Future offerings may include a TS101 course tailored for law enforcement personnel, and a League Cycling Instructor seminar for those who wish to teach bicycle education.
