



Celebrate the Opening of the New Multi-Use Path

Join the citizens of Carson City to celebrate the completion of the Linear Parkway / Route 6 multi-use path under the new freeway, connecting the existing path between Roop St and Moffat Open Space Preserve. People will ride, walk, roll, skate, skateboard, and scooter along the path towards the turn-around in Moffat Open Space, about six miles round trip. You can go as far as you like. There will be an optional extension to the Mexican Ditch Trail to the south, and the trails in Riverview Park at the end of Fifth St. A map of the path is on the reverse of this flier.

We will meet at 10:00AM on the north side of Governors Field, cut the ribbon at 10:15, and enter the path through a gate. You may also enter and exit the path where it crosses roads.

Free bicycle water bottles will be provided at Governors Field, and you can fill them there and again at Moffat Open Space. Bathrooms are at Governors Field and Moffat. Muscle Powered members will provide minor bicycle maintenance and adjustment. All bicycle riders should have helmets.

Wildlife and natural history abound along the path. Enjoy!
